Service Superannuation Plan

We wish to inform you that effective February 11, 2010, the NSAHO Pension Plan has entered into a new Reciprocal Transfer Agreement with the New Brunswick Public Service Superannuation Plan.

We are advising Plan Members of this new Agreement in the Fall 2009 newsletter; in a Note on the 2009 Annual Member Pension Statement; and as a News item on our website. We ask that you also assist us in advising Members by circulating the attached Member Notice. Please copy and circulate this notice to your employees via your internal mail system, your internal E- mail, as an insert in pay stub envelopes, and/or post it on bulletin boards throughout your facility. Since members new to the Plan in 2010 will not be receiving a 2009 Pension Statement and may not have received a newsletter, we ask that these members in particular are provided with this information if at all possible.

We appreciate your cooperation in helping the Plan to advise Members of this new agreement.

We also enclose a copy of our new "*Application for Enrollment/Re-Enrollment*" that references transfers under the Past Service section. Please discard your current supply of Enrollment Applications and replace it with the new version attached. The new form is available on our website as well.

**Notice to all active Members**  
**New Reciprocal Agreement in place with the New Brunswick**  
**Public Service Superannuation Plan**

Have you paid into the ***New Brunswick Public Service Superannuation Plan*** in the past? If your answer is yes, this memo will be of interest to you.

The NSAHO Pension Plan has just signed a new Reciprocal Transfer Agreement with the New Brunswick Public Service Superannuation Plan that may allow you to transfer your New Brunswick pension service into the NSAHO Pension Plan.

Our new agreement has an effective date of February 11, 2010.

To qualify to do a reciprocal transfer there are time limits and certain restrictions. **You must complete the transfer by February 11, 2011 or within one year of when you became a member of the NSAHO Pension Plan if later.**

In addition, you must have left your money in the New Brunswick Public Service Superannuation Plan when you ended your New Brunswick employment.

For further information or to find out if you qualify for a reciprocal transfer, please contact the NSAHO Pension Plan directly.
