RE: NSAHO Pension Plan – 2011 Plan Maximums

In anticipation of the required changes to your payroll system for the upcoming 2011 year, this memo gives details on the various maximums that apply to the NSAHO Pension Plan, effective with the beginning pay period in 2011.

• CPP's Yearly Maximum Pensionable Earnings (YMPE)	\$ 48,300.00
• Maximum Pensionable Earnings applicable to our Plan	\$142,101.00
• Maximum Pension Benefit that can be earned for the Year	\$ 2,552.22
• Maximum Employee Contributions	\$ 12,094.92
• Maximum Employer Contributions (if Employer did not participate in ERIP*)	\$ 14,122.13
• Maximum Employer Contributions (if Employer participated in ERIP*)	\$ 14,974.73

* ERIP – Early Retirement Incentive Plan that was in place from 1994 to 1998.

Reminder: The implementation date for changing the way that Employee/Employer Contributions are calculated is to take effect with the beginning of the 2011 payroll year – please refer to Bulletin 2010-04.
